EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1986, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the General Services and Consolidated Sewer & Water Budgets to cover the cost of union settlement; overtime/extra help; and CZM grant match.

That the 10th day of June, 19 86, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. ~~xxxxxxxixxxxxxxx~~, the Board of County Commissioners of Mason County, at the County Courthouse, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation to the budget for the General Services and Consolidated Sewer & Water Funds in the estimated amount of \$ 94,283 & 2,250 for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
