SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

GENERAL SERVICES - PARKS

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1990, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the Current Expense budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to unanticipated revenues from Simpson Timber Company \$7,740.00 and the Hood Canal Improvement Club \$747.46 for General Services - Parks.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:
