

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, TRANSFERRING THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT FROM GENERAL SERVICES TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND SUPERSEDING AND CANCELING RESOLUTION 37-90 WHICH INCORPORATED THE DIVISIONS OF CONSOLIDATED SEWER AND WATER AND LANDFILL INTO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS finds that combining numerous like functions under one department provides for efficient service to the citizens of Mason County,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Community Development shall be established and shall include the following functions:


1. Consolidated Sewer & Water
2. Landfill
3. Planning.

HOWEVER, nothing in this document shall be construed to restrict the Board of County Commissioners' authority to set policy for these functions of Mason County government even though, pursuant to this resolution, the above functions are delegated.
