SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1991, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to grants from the Department of Community Development for the purpose of operating emergency management services.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:


