

RESOLUTION NO. 31-92

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMIT
NORTH BAY ROAD

WHEREAS, the speed limits on county roads in Mason County, Washington, were fixed by Resolution on April 20, 1981, as 50 miles per hour, except certain roads as otherwise posted; and,

WHEREAS, existing conditions on North Bay Road, from M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 1.96, (that portion of SR 302 to be turned back to Mason County on April 2, 1992), warrants speed limit changes.




