SHERIFF'S BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1992, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a grant from the Washington State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for the Off Road Vehicle (O.R.V.) Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 23rd day of June, 1992 at the hour of 9:15 a.m., the Board of Mason County Commissioners at Courthouse Building I, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Sheriff's Department, in the estimated amount of \$26,736.00, for the above-mentioned purposes, and the Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice hearing to be published as provided by law.

That the 2nd day of June, 1992.




