BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer shall make an effort to dispose of the timber to the best advantage of Mason County and shall also keep the Board of County Commissioners advised on the progress of this activity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds from the sales of such timber logs be deposited in the County Road Fund.
