EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1992, it is necessary to establish to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Current Expense Fund to complete a trail in the Hood Canal Wetlands Project.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


The Clerk of the Board be and hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


