1994 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1994, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, because of unused 1993 grant funds from the Washington State Department of Health. These funds will be used to complete a Group B Public Water Systems Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners: That the 15th day of February, 1994 at the hour of 8:30 p.m., in the Mason County Commission Chambers at Courthouse Building I, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for Environmental Health in the estimated amount of \$15,312.00 for the above-mentioned purpose(s). The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of hearing to be published as provided by law.


