

RESOLUTION NO. 75-94

1994 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1994, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to an increase in the amount of Planning revenue from inspection fees/critical ordinance; zoning and subdivision fees; State Environmental Protection Act (SEPA) checklist fees; and an increase in operating transfers to GHCF Staff Support. These additional revenues will be used to fund additional clerical help and to upgrade a planner position.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


That the **16th day of August, 1994 at the hour of 7:30 p.m.** in the County Commission Chambers, Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for **Planning** in the amount of **\$57,750** and **GHCF Staff Support** in the estimated amount of **\$4,200** for the above-mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
