SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION BUDGET - NOTICE OF HEARING


WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1994, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriations to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to a Department of Community Trade and Economic Development grant. These funds are provided to communities to reduce the incidence of substance abuse in youth and families.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of hearing to be published as provided by law.


