MASON COUNTY/CITY OF SHELTON FUNDING DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Shelton and Mason County have chosen to participate in Growth Management efforts as mandated by the State of Washington through the Growth Management Act of 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development (CTED) has chosen to provide incentive grants for counties and cities whose GMA deadlines have passed and who wish to complete, improve, refine, or implement specific GMA products; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelton and Mason County are eligible for these funds but only for work that brings them into compliance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelton and Mason County have mutually determined that grant funds will be disbursed on a per capita basis equivalent to the city's proportion of total county population;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Shelton City Commission and the Mason County Board of Commissioners that, based on 1995 population estimates from OFM, the City of Shelton's total proportion of funding, for state fiscal years 1996 and 1997, shall amount to 19.78% of the funds made available to CTED (an example of how this works is attached as Exhibit A and made part of this agreement by this reference).
