1995 BUDGET

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1995, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Current Expense Fund for the Teamsters salary survey, moving costs, lease payments on Pritchard Building, sick leave/vacation leave payouts and unemployment costs .

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


