1995 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1995, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to unanticipated grant revenue from the WA State Department of Ecology for the Combined Sewer and Water (CS&W) Fund and the Landfill Fund.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:
