

STATE REVOLVING LOAN

RESOLUTION NO 100-96

IN THE MATTER OF:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF MASON TO RECEIVE A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology, a Washington State Agency, has established a State Revolving Fund (SRF) for providing financial assistance to Rustlewood to construct sewage collection system improvements for the purpose of reducing infiltration and inflow into the system. The improvements will include pipe and manhole replacement, manhole grouting, and sidesewer replacement in the public right-of-way.

WHEREAS, the County of Mason desires to participate in a loan from said State Revolving Fund; and

WHEREAS, a requirement to participate requires a resolution of the governing body authorizing the County of Mason to receive a State Revolving Fund Loan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY OF MASON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The County of Mason desires to participate in the State Revolving Fund Loan Program.

SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mason does hereby authorize the County of Mason to receive a State Revolving Fund Loan and to take such other actions as are necessary and relevant to the State Revolving Fund Loan Program.

SECTION 3. It is the intent of the Mason County Board of Commissioners to fund the Rustlewood Wastewater Treatment Facility I/I Project per the Rustlewood Sanitary Sewer System Infiltration and Inflow Study utilizing the revenue collected from the Rustlewood property owners described therein.
