

RESOLUTION NO. 128-96

AMENDS RESOLUTION NO. 3-88

RESOLUTION ALLOWING COUNTY OFFICES TO CHARGE \$18 FOR ALL RETURNED CHECKS

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Board of Mason County Commissioners that taxpayer's funds are being expended to process a "non-negotiable" check, and

WHEREAS, it is a convenience to the public to be allowed to make payments to the County in the form of a check, and

WHEREAS, it has been ascertained that charging a service fee on all checks requiring reprocessing is necessary to recover some of the labor and handling costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Mason County offices are authorized to make a charge of eighteen (\$18.00) dollars to reprocess a "non-negotiable" check.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each County office shall receive a copy of this resolution and shall post a notice to this effect.
