WHEREAS, the invasive non-native aquatic weed Brazilian Elodia has been identified in Lake Limerick, and

WHEREAS, Brazilian Elodia poses a threat to the ecosystem and public safety of Lake Limerick, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Limerick Country Club has establish an approved aquatic weed management plan for Lake Limerick, and

WHEREAS, control of this problem exceeds the immediate financial capital of the Lake Limerick Country Club, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Limerick Country Club is not eligible for state grant or loan assistance by themselves, and

WHEREAS, Mason County and the Lake Limerick Country Club desire to enter into partnership in the management of the invasive weed problem.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MASON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

- 1) That the county sponsor the loan request for the Lake Limerick Aquatic Weed Project and accept the line of credit from the State of Washington Department of Ecology;
- 2) That the Chairman of the Board or a majority of the Board be authorized to execute such documents necessary for acceptance of the loan upon review and approval thereof by the Director of Health Services and Civil Prosecutor.
