1996 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1996, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to funds from the Department of ecology for the Comprehensive Flood Hazard Management Plan for the Skokomish River Basin and funds from the US Department of Transportation for a hazardous material survey and exercise.
