SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1996, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, due to grant funds from the WA State Dept of Ecology and private contributions.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


