RESOLUTION NO. <u>03-99</u> AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 133-98 IMPLEMENTING A 1.7% SALARY INCREASE FOR CERTAIN NON-UNION EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, RCW 36.40.080 states that"...the Board of county commissioners shall fix and determine each item of the budget separately and shall by resolution adopt the budget...";

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.070 states that"...the Board shall fix the compensation of all employees...";

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the compensation of certain non-union employees should be increased:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby amend the non-union salary plan (Attachment A) by increasing salaries of regular full-time and regular part-time non-union employees 1.7% effective January 1, 1999. Such increase shall not be applicable to employees in the class of Juvenile Detention Officer since they are now represented by a Union, nor to those Deputy Prosecutors compensated on the Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys Salary Plan.
