

**MASON COUNTY ROAD FUND**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 10-99**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, MASON COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mason County Commissioners have met and considered the Road Fund Budget for the calendar year 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mason County Commissioners, in the course of considering the Road Fund Budget for 1999 have reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mason County Commissioners have determined that, due to extensive weather damage to county roads and to protect future road property tax levy capacity, there is a substantial need to increase the regular property tax levy rate above the rate of inflation, as defined by the implicit price deflator (IPD).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Mason County Commissioners that the limit factor for the regular levy for the Road Fund for the calendar year 1999 shall be 6.0% of the highest amount of regular property taxes that could have been lawfully levied in Mason County in any year since 1985.
