

RESOLUTION NO. 103 -99

**1999 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING**

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: unbudgeted beginning fund balance to be used for the cost of mandatory arbitration in Human Resources, the increase in Superior Court Judges salaries, and the cost of court security officer; and a grant from WA State Community Trade and Economic Development to be used by the Planning Department to fulfill requirements under the Growth Management Act.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **5th day of October, 1999 at the hour of 9:15 a.m in the Mason County Commission Chambers, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington**, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for: the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$7,130.


The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


