1999 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: Community Juvenile Accountability Act training costs in Probation Services; development of a "Food & Family " program in Cooperative Extension, an error in salary computation in Licensing/Auditor's Office and a recycling grant for the Landfill.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1999 at the hour of 10:30 a.m. in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$22,820 and the Landfill Fund in the estimated amount of \$32,000 for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
