EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION – NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the: ***District Court for operating expenses resulting from an increase in the number of trials and changes in State laws.***
