

RESOLUTION NO. 135 -99

1999 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: unbudgeted beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund to be used for the "batting cage project" at MCRA Park; a residual equity transfer from Current Expense Fund to the Abatement Fund for the abatement of dangerous buildings; and unbudgeted beginning fund balance in the Law Library Fund for the purchase of law book.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **14th day of December, 1999 at the hour of 9:55 a.m in the Mason County Commission Chambers, 411 North Fifth Street**, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for:

Current Expense Fund	\$9,690
Abatement Fund	\$7,035
Law Library	\$5,000


