EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for emergency appropriation(s) to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.140, to meet an outstanding obligation of the Facilities and Grounds, Jail/Sheriff's Department & LEOFF I Medical.

That the 30th day of December, 1999 at the hour of 1:30 ^{p.m.} ~~a.m.~~, in the County Commission Chambers, Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, be and the same hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the emergency appropriation(s) to the budget for Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$102,000.




