

RESOLUTION NO. 157-99
ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL DAYS DURING THE YEAR 2000
MASON COUNTY OFFICES WILL NOT BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR BUSINESS

WHEREAS, RCW 36.16.100 states "All county and precinct offices shall be kept open for the transaction of business during such days and hours as the board of county commissioners shall by resolution prescribe."

WHEREAS, due to limited financial and personnel resources, the Board of Mason County Commissioners find it necessary to close Mason County Offices to the public for public business one day each month during the year 2000;

WHEREAS, these closures are in addition to holiday closures established by RCW 1.16.050 and Mason County Code 2.28.030;


