1999 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: **potential State and FEMA grants for emergency expenditures by the Emergency Services Department and the Permit Assistance Center during the recent landslide disaster.**

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


