1999 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 1999, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: a Cops in Schools, universal hiring grant from the federal government and intergovernmental revenue from the North Mason School District.

These funds will be used to hire and assign a deputy sheriff to the North Mason School District.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 17th day of August at the hour of 11:15 a.m. in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for:

The Sheriff's Department, Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$19,295.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


