

**MASON COUNTY**  
**COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO.: 7-2000**  
**COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO.: 1637**

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 62310, known locally as the Trails Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 34, T22N, R2W and Sec. 3, T21N, R2W, WM, M.P. 3.32 to M.P. 4.38 (Fire Hall to 5-Pipes), work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this is a 3R Project identified as Item No. 27 of the officially adopted 2000-2005 Six Year Transportation Improvement Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

3-R Project

Perform Preliminary Engineering, Right of Way acquisition, Relax Curves, Grade/Drain/Surface with 3 inches of Asphalt Concrete Paving.

SAID WORK is to be performed by contract in accordance with the Washington State Standard (day labor/contract)

Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:


Engineering	\$ <u>60,000.00</u>
Right-of-Way	\$ <u>10,000.00</u>
Road Construction	\$ <u>200,000.00</u> (Preparation - \$20,000 // A/C- \$180,000)



ADOPTED this 11th day of January, 2000.


