

RESOLUTION NO. 125-00
2000 BUDGET
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to**: The cost of the November 2000 general election in the Auditor/Elections Department and the cost of utilities and repairs & maintenance in the Facilities & Grounds/Jail Department. These supplemental budget appropriations will be funded by unanticipated timber revenue.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 26TH **day of December, 2000** at the hour of **10:45 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the **Current Expense Fund** in the estimated amount of **\$38,000** for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


