

RESOLUTION NO. 22.00
2000 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to**: unanticipated beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund to be used for a position reclassification in the Prosecutor's Office and to correct budget discrepancies in District Court; interfund charges for services in the Prosecutor's Office to fund salaries of Deputy Prosecuting Attorneys during the days Mason County is closed to the public for public business; unbudgeted Boating Program cash on hand to be used for the Boating Program; Smoke Detector Grant reimbursements for the smoke detector program; unanticipated beginning fund balance and a federal grant for the jail expansion project in the Capital Improvement Fund.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


That the 4th day of **April, 2000** at the hour of **9:15 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of **\$115,837** and the Capital Improvement Fund in the estimated amount of **\$234,974** for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
