WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 due to: An unanticipated operating transfer from the Capital Improvement Fund to Facilities & Grounds; unanticipated Oyster Fest revenue; unanticipated interfund charges for services for Human Resources and Budget & Finance; and unanticipated beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund for general purposes and the MCRA Batting Cage Program. These resources will be used to restore budget cuts resulting from the passage of I-695, reclassify a deputy prosecutor position, and to help construct the MCRA Batting Cage.
