COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO.: 1626-R

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 97500, known locally as Belfair-Tahuya Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 34, T23N - R2 W, WM, M.P. 9.60, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 5 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

(Upper Stimson Creek)

Replace existing 3' diameter corrugated metal pipe with 10' diameter x 130' corrugated metal pipe.

SAID WORK is to be performed by day labor/contract in accordance with the Washington State Standard (day labor/contract) Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Road Construction	\$ <u>\$75,000.00</u>




