

**RESOLUTION NO. 42-00**  
**2000 BUDGET**

**SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING**

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to**: a residual equity transfer from the ER&R Fund to the Reserve for Technology Fund for technological improvements in county communication and information systems.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **23<sup>rd</sup>** day of **May, 2000** at the hour of **7:10 p.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Reserve for Technology Fund #119-000-000 in the estimated amount of \$250,000 for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


