2000 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to**: federal grants from the Dept. of Justice for laptop computers and other small tools and equipment in the Sheriff's Office; a state grant from the Office of Financial Management and grants from US West and A T & T for a livescan fingerprint system in the Sheriff's Office; and unanticipated beginning fund balance for computer software for the Prosecutor's Office.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the **13th** day of **June, 2000** at the hour of **9:10 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$87,630 for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.


