

RESOLUTION NO. 51-00
2000 BUDGET

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to**: the receipt of local government assistance from the WA State Legislature which will be used to: partially restore budget cuts due to the loss of MVET revenue, fund the reclassification of the internal auditor/accountant in the Auditor's Office; funding licensing staff to work longer than budgeted at the Belfair Annex; fund increasing a clerk in the District Court to full-time; fund hiring a deputy prosecutor at a higher range and step than budgeted. Also, unbudgeted beginning fund balance for the WRIF 16 grant which will be used to hire a consultant.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners:


That the 20th day of **June, 2000** at the hour of **10:00 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of **\$365,816** and the **Health Services** Fund in the estimated amount of \$32,761 the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.




