2000 BUDGET  
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION - NOTICE OF HEARING

**WHEREAS**, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2000, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100, and RCW 36.40.195 **due to: the WA State tobacco settlement and indirect federal medicaid administrative match to be used by the Personal Health/Nursing Department for a new community health education specialist position and to increase the hours of support staff.**

**And;**

**FEMA reimbursement for Y2K preparedness, fees for services, facilities rent, miscellaneous revenue and unanticipated beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund to be used by the Emergency Management Department for salaries and operating expenses.**

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners:

That the 17<sup>th</sup> day of **October, 2000** at the hour of **9:45 a.m.** in the Mason County Commission Chambers, at Courthouse Building 1, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of the supplemental appropriation to the budget for the: **Health Services Fund** in the estimated amount of **\$12,300** and the **Current Expense Fund** in the estimated amount of **\$34,500** for the above mentioned purposes.

The Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to cause notice of such hearing to be published as provided by law.
