ALLOCATION OF SHB 2060 LOW INCOME HOUSING MONEY

WHEREAS, Senate House Bill 2060 was established to provide money for low income housing programs in Mason County for extremely low and very low income people, using the HUD guidelines;


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes there is a tremendous need for low income housing programs in Mason County;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Housing Authority and the City of Shelton reviewed the two proposals submitted and recommended to the Board of County Commissioners approval;


NOW THEREFORE, The Board of County Commissioners of Mason County does hereby approve the allocation of Senate House Bill 2060 low income housing money as follows: \$25,000 to the Mason County Shelter and \$10,000 to the Southern Puget Sound Inter-Tribal Housing Authority subject to the execution of an agreement with Mason County pertaining to the use of funds.




