COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO.: 23-03
COUNTY ROAD PROJECT NO.: 1788

WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 41640, known locally as the Skokomish Valley Road, and more specifically located in Section 18, Township 21 North, Range 4 West, WM, M.P. 4.3 to M.P. 4.4, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 4 on the officially adopted County Annual Road Program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Perform preliminary engineering and construction. Place large woody debris and rip rap for bank stabilization, and enhance bank vegetation with native plants.

SAID WORK is to be performed by Contract in accordance with the Washington State (day labor/contract) Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:

Engineering	\$ <u>10,000.00</u>
Right-of-Way	\$ <u>----</u>
Construction	\$ <u>50,000.00</u>



ADOPTED this 4th day of March, 2003.


