WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that safety policies and programs are beneficial to the County and its employees;


WHEREAS, the Board wishes to provide hearing protection to employees and volunteers exposed to high levels of noise on the job;


NOW THEREFORE, The Board of County Commissioners of Mason County does hereby adopt the Mason County Hearing Conservation Program.




