WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120(6) states that the Board of County Commissioners have responsibility for the care of county property and the management of county funds and business;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that safety policies and programs are beneficial to the County and its employees;


WHEREAS, The Board wishes to provide protection from tuberculosis to employees considered to be "at risk" in their job classification;


NOW THEREFORE, The Board of County Commissioners of Mason County does hereby adopt the Mason County Tuberculosis Exposure Control Plan.
