## RESOLUTION NO. 96.03 APPROVING 2004 TITLE III PROJECT UNDER SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY SELF-DETERMINATION ACT OF 2000 PUBLIC LAW 106-393

WHEREAS, Public Law 106-393 was approved by Congress "(1) To stabilize payments to counties to provide funding for schools and roads that supplements other available funds. (2) To make additional investments in, and create additional employment opportunities through, projects that improve the maintenance of existing infrastructure, implement stewardship objectives that enhance forest ecosystems, and restore and improve land health and water and water quality...(3) To improve cooperative relationships among the people that use and care for Federal lands and the agencies that manage these lands."

*WHEREAS*, the Mason County 4-H Forestry Leadership Program meets the criteria for projects under Title III of Public Law 106-393, and the program has been very successful in reaching youth in Mason County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Mason County Commissioners does hereby approve the Mason County 4-H Forestry Leadership Program as Mason County's Title III project for 2004.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Mason County will fund the Mason County 4-H Forestry Leadership Program from Federal Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act (Public Law 106-393) revenue.
