

RESOLUTION NO. 18-04
2004 BUDGET
Supplemental Appropriation – Notice of Hearing

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2004, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195 due to an operating transfer from the Cumulative Reserve Beards Cove Fund to the Beards Cove Water (Operations) Fund for the painting of the reservoir and new well number five; and unbudgeted beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund to be used for necessary expenses of the Noxious Weed Board.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:




