WHEREAS, on Mason County Road No. 41640, known locally as the Skokomish Valley Road, and more specifically located in Sec. 16, T21N, R4W, WM;, M.P. 1.51 to M.P. 2.01, work defined as "construction" in the BARS Manual, Page II-63, et seq, is determined to be necessary and proper; and,

WHEREAS, this project is identified as # 23 on the officially adopted 2004 – 2009 six year road program.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that it is their intention to:

Perform preliminary engineering and right of way for the future realignment and reconstruction of the Hunter Creek Bridge.

SAID WORK is to be performed by day labor in accordance with the Washington State  
day labor/contract)  
Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction as adopted by Mason County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above described County Road Project is necessary and proper, and the estimated costs of said project are herewith set out as follows:


