

RESOLUTION NO. 73-04
2004 BUDGET
Supplemental Appropriation – Notice of Hearing

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2004, it is necessary to make provision for supplemental appropriation to the budget as required by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195 due to unanticipated revenue from timber harvest on State Forest Board Lands which will be used to help fund the County's liability for payoffs of accrued leave and unanticipated beginning fund balance in the Current Expense Fund which will be used to fund unanticipated costs of the Hearing Examiner.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners:



Current Expense Fund in the estimated amount of \$420,000
Reserve for Accrued Leave Fund in the estimated amount of \$400,000


