

RESOLUTION NO. 100-06
TO ESTABLISH VICTIM WITNESS ACTIVITIES FUND (114-000-000)

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120 states “.. the board of county commissioners...have the care of the county property and the management of the county funds and business..”


WHEREAS, the WA State Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development (CTED) has provided funding to the Mason County Prosecuting Attorney to hire an additional .5 FTE (full time equivalent) employee to assist in meeting the needs of victims of crime in the Mason County community;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mason County Board of County Commissioners does hereby establish the Victim Witness Activities Fund (114-000-000) to receive revenues and pay certain specific costs of meeting the needs of victims of crime in Mason County.

IT IS FURTHER ESTABLISHED THAT the Mason County Prosecuting Attorney will administer this fund and pay proper expenses from this fund as approved by the Mason County Board of County Commissioners.


