

RESOLUTION NO. 16-06
ALLOCATION OF SHB 2060 LOW INCOME HOUSING MONEY
COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES FUND #117

WHEREAS, Senate House Bill 2060 was established to provide money for low income housing programs in Mason County for extremely low and very low income people, using the HUD guidelines;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes there is a tremendous need for emergency shelters and low income housing programs in Mason County;

WHEREAS, the Cold & Hungry Coalition has submitted an application for 2060 low income housing funding in the amount of \$16,000 to operate emergency cold weather shelters in Shelton and Belfair, Washington;

WHEREAS, the Mason County Housing Coalition has submitted a letter supporting the Cold & Hungry Coalition's request for \$16,000 as it meets the Tier One priorities identified in the 2004 Mason County Continuum of Care Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, The Board of Mason County Commissioners does hereby approve the allocation of Senate House Bill 2060 low income housing money in the amount of \$16,000 subject to the execution of an agreement with Mason County pertaining to the use of funds.
