

RESOLUTION NO. 36-08

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MASON COUNTY REGIONAL TRAILS PLAN, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF COUNTYWIDE TRAILS, BIKEWAYS, AND WATER TRAILS.

WHEREAS, the Mason County Parks Plan recommended that the County complete a Regional Trails Plan, and

WHEREAS, a Regional Trails Plan is needed to develop a systematic approach to developing a trail system in Mason County, and

WHEREAS, Mason County received a National Park Service Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance Program Grant and a citizens Trails Committee was formed to complete the Regional Trails Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Regional Trails Plan has been developed that includes a plan development process, development policies, review of existing trails and bikeways in Mason County, community need for trails and bikeways, key issues and opportunities, design standards and guidelines, trail development recommendations, funding options, public involvement process, and

WHEREAS, the completion of the Trails Plan was a priority work item for the Parks and Trails Department in 2007;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mason County Commissioners Adopt the Mason County Regional Trails Plan, For the Development of Countywide Trails, Bikeways, and Water Trails;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Regional Trails Plan, For the Development of Countywide Trails, Bikeways and Water Trails shall be utilized to establish partnerships with public and private organizations to develop trails, bikeways and water trails and to establish funding sources for the development and maintenance of trails, bikeways, and water trails in Mason County in the future.


