

RESOLUTION NO. 94-08
2008 BUDGET
Supplemental Appropriation Notice of Hearing

WHEREAS, by reason of conditions which could not be reasonably foreseen at the time of making the budget for the year 2008, it is necessary to make provisions for supplemental appropriations to the 2008 Budget as authorized by RCW 36.40.100 and RCW 36.40.195 for the following:

Supplemental appropriations for a grant from the WA State Archives, Office of the Secretary of State to the Clerk/Current Expense Fund for a Microfilm Reader Printer; a grant from the WA State Sex Offender Address and Residency Verification Program to the Sheriff/Current Expense Fund to verify registered sex offenders' place of residence, additional grant funds from the WA State Dept of Community, Trade & Economic Development (CTED) Office of Crime Victims Advocacy to the Prosecutor's Victim Witness Activities Fund to hire staff to assist victims and witnesses during the criminal justice process and a grant from the Office of the Secretary of State/Archive and Records Management to the Department of Community Development (DCD Archival Retention Fund) to hire a temporary employee to image, scan, and index DCD files for archival retention.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Mason County Commissioners:

That the 12th of August at the hour of 9:30 AM in the Mason County Commissioners Chambers in Courthouse Building I, 411 North Fifth Street, Shelton, Washington, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing upon the matter of these supplemental appropriations to the 2008 Budget as follows:

Victim Witness Activities Fund in the estimated amount of \$19,000
DCD Archival Retention Fund in the estimated amount of \$28,875
